

# THE FIRST ANNUAL GHOULFEST COFFIN RACE

## Last Saturday in October

#### Pre-Race

- 1) Build a Coffin- Each team will produce a coffin conforming to the attached Coffin Specification. Each Coffin will be inspected by the Race officials prior to the race. If your coffin does not pass the inspection you will be removed from the race but can still participate in the parade. Any questions or disagreements will be addressed by the Lead official.
- 2) Prizes- Trophies will be presented to the 3 fastest race times along with: Best Entourage, Best Coffin and Best Ghoul.
- 3) Select your group- Each race team needs four people to push and one to be the Ghoul in the coffin. All racers and ghoul must be 18 or older. Entourage and parade participants can be any age.
- 4) Safety Gear- All racers are encouraged to wear protective gear (Helmets, knee pads etc.) The Ghoul MUST wear helmet during the race.
- **5) Race Registration-** All Pushers and Ghouls must be registered by **3:30pm**. If you are not registered by than you will be considered a no show and not allowed to participate in the events.
- **6) Hold Harmless** All members of your team must sign the Hold Harmless agreement on race day.
- **7) Submission Deadline**: October 22<sup>nd</sup>, 2023 submission must be made to City of Geneva

#### Race Day

- 1) **Judged-** Your Coffin, Entourage and ghouls will be judged during the lineup. People's Choice will be determined after the parade.
- 2) **Drivers meeting-** One member from each team MUST attend the drivers meeting to go over the rules, line up and answer any questions.
- 3) **Line up-** At the drivers meeting you will be given your Coffin number for line up. Please remain in line so we can make the race run smoothly and that all spectators get the opportunity to see you in all of your Swagger.

#### Race Rules


- 1) NO alcohol or Drugs- There is NO public consumption of alcohol or drugs. You will be disqualified and will be asked to leave the event and will not be able to participate in the future of this event.
- 2) Race- the race course is 585 feet (195 yards) headed towards Eagle Street. Racing times of each team are recorded as two teams race each other. The overall fastest timed racing team will be the winner.
- 3) Hands on the Coffin- Three of the four pushers must keep their hands on the coffin until the coffin has crossed the finish line and stopped completely. Any coffin that has less than three pushers in direct contact with the coffin during the race will be deemed out of control and will be disqualified. Changing Ghouls/Pushers after sign ups is prohibited and will disqualify the team. In case of injury prior to race time, the race officials have the authority to allow the substitution.
- 4) Lane- Pushers must keep the coffin in their lane. You can touch the yellow line but if a pusher or coffin cross the yellow line your team is disqualified.
- 5) **Disputes-**Protests can only be made by the participants and must go to the director of the race no later than 10 minutes after the race. The decision will ultimately be made by the Director and it will be final.

# COFFIN SPECIFICATIONS

All coffins must meet the following specifications. Coffins will be inspected prior to the race during "tech inspect". Coffins not meeting specifications will be disqualified at time of inspection.



- 1. The coffin measured at the widest point, including wheelbase and/or handles and push bars, must be between 2' and 3' 10" wide. Length must be between 5' and 8', including handles and push bars. There are no height restrictions for coffins, but decorations over 10 feet tall must be removeable. Decorative projections that exceed the maximum width and length of the coffin specifications are not permitte
- 2. Four handles must be securely attached to coffin. Push bar on the front or back of the coffin is optional and may be added instead of 2 of the four handles. Ropes are not permitted.
- 3. Each coffin must have four firmly attached wheels, attached in such a manner that coffin will roll on all 4 wheels when propelled down the race course. Wheels may not exceed 8.25" in diameter, including tires. Wheels must be within the overall dimensions of the coffin. Casters may be used. For safety and steering ability, wheels or casters may rotate or swivel.
- 4. Functional steering mechanisms are prohibited.
- 5. Registration number must be visible on the front of your coffin & the back of Emma.
- 6. SAFETY IS IMPERATIVE! Race officials may disqualify any coffin they feel is dangerous.
