RE: Public / Private Property Access for Field Investigations

The City of Geneva is performing a storm water master study to identify and evaluate storm water issues throughout the city. Storm water issues under evaluation include but are not limited to chronic surface flooding, erosion and aging infrastructure. The results of the evaluation will be utilized by the city to develop future solutions. The project is being performed by CT Consultants as the prime consultant with Joe Pavlick as the Project Manager.

Field investigations are important to better understand the storm water system. These investigations may require private and public property access in order to access stream channels, manholes or other assets. Per ORC Section 715.40, 41, 47, the City has the right to access such property within the municipal corporation for these purposes.
