

City of Geneva Yard Waste Disposal Program

The City is happy to announce that the Yard Waste Program will begin starting on the 2nd Monday in May and ending on the 4th Monday of September.

Yard Waste must be on the tree lawn and will be picked up on every 2nd and 4th Monday of the month.

Please Note: We will pick up bags that are recyclable with ONLY YARD WASTE!

The only items to be placed in recyclable bags (NOT TAPED SHUT) are:

- Leaves
- Grass Clippings
- Old Mulch
- Flower bed clippings
- Small twigs

Tree limbs, bushes, tree wood, and smaller limbs need to be tied together or placed in a container that can be dumped into our trucks. We will leave the container.

All items are to be placed on the tree lawn the night before. If it is not out it will not be picked up until the next scheduled pickup date.

Absolutely NONE of the following items are permitted and will not be picked up and disposed of:

- Metal
- Plastic (including garbage bags)
- Garbage of any type
- Batteries
- Plywood
- Hazardous waste (for example: oil, paint, etc..)
- Landscape timbers
- Lattice
- RR ties
- Any other type of building materials
- Infectious waste (including Animal waste)
- Asbestos

Notice: When raking out your flower beds REMOVE ANY AND ALL MATERIALS listed above. If found in your yard waste the bags and materials will be left on your tree lawn and not removed or picked up.

This services is being provided to our residents and it is not intended to for owners wishing to remove trees or clear land or lots. That is the responsibility of the land owners to dispose of.
