City Manager Report:

West Main Street Sewer Replacement Project

Since the road closure three weeks ago, the contractor has made significant progress. The road will remain closed until further notice. The next progress meeting is scheduled for Wednesday, November 13, 2024 at 1:00 p.m.

CDBG Senior Center ADA Project

The project began two weeks ago. The contractor is making good progress. The timeframe for completion is mid-December.

OPWC Round 39 Lawn Street Waterline Replacement Project

The full application has been submitted. The city should hear by next spring. This is a \$700,000 project to be completed in 2025.

2025 Property & Casualty Insurance (P&C) Renewal

The property & casualty insurance renewal has been received from our carrier, the Public Entities Pool. The 2024 premium of \$84,482 will increase to \$89,879 in 2025, a 6.4% increase. The 2023 renewal under the previous plan was \$130,700.

Planning Commission
